- Attend at least four Youth Board meetings a year. Meetings usually last 1 – 2hrs and take place at the Theatre Royal Haymarket in London's West End
- Have a thorough understanding of the work of the charity, both as a member of Masterclass and as a Youth Board member
- Take part in the programme throughout the year (i.e. attend at least four events including Masterclasses, Creative Conversations/Workshops & Script Scratch)
- · Commit to 8hrs a month of engaging with Masterclass
- Act as an advocate for the charity and our programming
- Learn more about the legal duties, responsibilities and liabilities of trusteeship
- · Exercise independent judgement

What we will offer:

- Mentoring with a range of creatives over the course of the year
- Opportunity to develop the skills required to join the Board of a charity or theatre
- Development of skills relevant to your role
- · Opportunity to have a creative impact on projects
- Free tickets to theatre shows (as part of team outings)
- Opportunities for work in our office
